PURPOSE



The Virginia Elected Officials Leadership Academy is a voluntary certification program open to elected officials in VML-member cities, towns and counties. The purpose is to encourage continuing education, promote excellence in local governance and recognize local elected officials who take advantage of training opportunities.

FORMAT



The Virginia Elected Officials Leadership Academy uses existing opportunities such as conferences and seminars along with courses offered through universities to offer meaningful, informative and useful information on topics that will expand the knowledge and capabilities of local officials.

The Academy is:

- Voluntary
- Based on participation (not tests)
- Recognizes individual credits that participants accumulate
- Aimed at mayors, council members, board chairs and supervisors in VML-member localities.

CERTIFICATION



Completion of the program leads to the attainment of a Certified Local Government Official (CLGO) designation as the first level of achievement and the Advanced Certified Local Government Official (ACLGO) as the second level.

Attainment of the CLGO requires a minimum of 40 credits; 75 credits are required for attainment of the ACLGO.
