



30 minutes to GA airport





FY2025 Annual Budget - \$35.5 million

Eligible Projects

- Runway, taxiway & apron construction/rehabilitation
- Land and easement acquisitions
- Airport master plans & environmental plans
- Airport access roads
- Fueling systems
- ARFF equipment & snow removal equipment
- Hangar site preparation
- Terminal & maintenance equipment buildings

- Funding Ratios (percent)
 - FAA/State/Local 90/8/2
 - State/Local 80/20
 - Funding rations based on project type

Purpose

- Explore business and economic development opportunities for airports
- Build closer working relationships with VEDP, localities and local Economic Development offices



Initiatives

- Governor's New Airline Service Incentive Fund (NASIF)
 - Committee discussions led to the creation of the NASIF
 - Provides marketing assistance to airlines starting new service
- Successes include
 - Breeze Airways at Norfolk and Richmond
 - United Airlines at Dulles
 - American Service at DCA



Initiatives

Airport Program Manual Modernization

- Supported and advised changes proposed by the Department
- > Site preparation at airports for aeronautical development
- Removed restrictions on uses
- Eliminated claw back
- Indexed funding cap amounts

Advanced Air Mobility Initiatives

- Three-phase Power/Broadband
- AAM project eligibility
- Funding changes to accelerate airport development and leverage Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) projects
