Virginia Municipal League installs new Board of Directors

Continuing as at-large members on the Board are Robert Wood, Town Manager for the Town of Rocky Mount; Dr. Amelia Ross-Hammond, Council Member for the City of Virginia Beach; and Becky Nave, Mayor for the City of Bristol.

The Board of Directors is rounded out by Immediate Past President Steve Trivett, Mayor for the Town of Ashland; Urban Section Chair Dany Fleming, Vice Mayor for the City of Harrisonburg; City Section Chair Renée Turk, Mayor for the City of Salem; and Town Section Chair Michael Stovall, Council Member for the Town of Vinton. The section chairs were elected during section meetings held earlier in the day.

VML's Board of Directors oversees the activities of the league. Representatives of the Board of Directors must be elected or appointed officials of a city, town, or county that is a member of VML.
